

Proof of the Existence of Universal Intelligence and Innate Intelligence

MANY a time man makes up his mind positively about a thing, for instance, he makes up his mind and determines to undertake a journey. Then, he begins to think, that is, he consults his inner reality and finally concludes that he will give up his journey. Why is it? How is it he gave up his original purpose? Thus it is evident that there is a reality in him and he consults that reality, and that reality expresses to him the harm which such a journey would cause. Therefore the man pays attention to that reality and gives up the plan of the journey. What is that reality that is speaking? It is the agent or that something of Universal Intelligence, within man which we shall call Innate Intelligence.

This leads me to the major premise upon which Chiropractic is based: "Universal Intelligence is in all matter, and continually gives to it, its properties and actions, thus maintaining it in existence."

Therefore, man, as a living being, has a material portion and also a spiritual or mental portion, but neither can function as living man, independently. The two are as one. If the spiritual, or mental, or Innate Intelligence leaves that body, then that body is non-existent, as man, or dead. By studying history, we find, that approximately 400 years before the time of Christ, man was studied as man actually existed, the material and the immaterial. At about that time Thales saw fit to divide man for the purposes of study and man has been studied in this manner until 1895, when Chiropractic was first released to this generation. I probably could have said that Chiropractic was discovered, but I do not care to look upon it in this manner as discovery, as discovery indicates to me that it is accidental. I prefer to think it was released by Universal Intelligence to D. D. Palmer. I feel that his life was pre-ordained. Just the same as B. J. Palmer has been put here on this earth for a certain purpose and that purpose is to develop and advance the science. So, he too is pre-ordained. We all are.

Man, as stated before, was divided and considered as two separate units. In other words, the union of the material and the immaterial, the concrete and the abstract which makes motion, which makes life, which makes function, was separated and acted upon accordingly, with the result we have had during the past two thousand years or more, two distinct and separate studies of man, when in reality man is the combination of the concrete and the abstract, for if

these two are divided or separated in reality, we have what is known and termed as non-existence or death. Therefore we see how absurd a conflict has been taking place down through the years and will continue to take place until the people become educated, and not only educated, educationally, but educated through practice, through the application of the science of Chiropractic, for there are three kinds of faith; first, that which is from tradition and birth, for example, a child is born of Mohammedan parents he is a Mohammedan. This faith is weak traditional faith. Second, that which comes from knowledge and is the faith of understanding; this is good, but there is a better, the faith of practice or application. This is real faith.

When this time comes, through the application of Chiropractic, the efficiency of peoples and nations will be of a much higher standard than exists today.

Referring to the two divisions as before mentioned, I now have in mind, the abstract and the concrete portions of man as they were divided and studied separately. The abstract, or spiritual, or mental, as you wish to refer to it, was given to one group of people for study. This group is what is termed the religionists and I refer to it with all due respect for they have and are doing some good constructive work. At this time, while I have mentioned religion, I would like to point out to you the fact, that since that time and down through the years, this one portion of study of man has again been divided and subdivided until today we have hundreds of different creeds sects and cults. There is only one Truth, so why the necessity of so many divisions for study.

Another group, were given the concrete portion or side of man to study and act upon, and now I am referring to what is termed the physician, and I refer also to that group with due respect. As far as studying the two portions of man was or is concerned, no harm was or is being done, but when the application of each is administered separately and independently, upon what is actually one unit, they do not arrive at a satisfactory result, for the abstract and the concrete are inseparable during life of man. It is the union of the two that is life.

It has been the custom which has been handed down from parents and ancestors, that when a preacher of the religion has a pain, ache, or is bodily ill, he goes to the physician for advice and relief. The physician then prescribes and treats from the outside for something inside, after he has had the preacher tell him

of his pains, aches, and bodily symptoms. He is treating from effect not cause, forgetting that there cannot be an effect without a cause. When the physician has a mental pain, mental ache, or any illness of a mental character, he goes to the preacher. And I say this with all due respect, for they do indeed heal mentally and inspire those who are discouraged and down-hearted, providing he does know the true meaning of truth and religion.

Somewhere between, there should be and is a connecting link that binds the abstract and concrete, the immaterial and the material, for the betterment of the human race. The two do exist as a fact, so why not face a common fact. In a later chapter, I will endeavor to bring this forth more clearly as it pictures itself in my mind.

I feel that I should give further proof of the existence of an Innate Intelligence, which is, that SOMETHING within us all. Innate within us is as sane as the sane law that governs the universe. The law that governs the sun is sane.

I would like to remind you briefly of the development of the embryo, the foetus, and up to the point when the child is expelled into the outer world as an independent unit. At the time of conception, we know that the ovum of the female is impregnated by the spermatozoon of the male, resulting in the fusion of the two cells, forming the blastoderm. At first it is very tiny, but it immediately commences to grow and develop its cells or probably expand its cells. From the beginning, law and systematic order prevails. There are millions and trillions of cells of different kinds to be placed, each one to occupy a particular place and to carry on a particular function. There is no confusion. Harmony and coordination exists in the highest degree. There are bone cells, muscle cells, connective tissue cells, ligamentous cells, cartilaginous cells, nerve cells, hair cells, finger and toe nail cells, and numerous other cells and all are being rightly placed in the child. Not only are they properly placed, but they are of different sizes, and each size has its function to perform in its proper position. From close examination, it is found that the cells are of different shapes, sizes, colors, densities, and grow and develop with different speeds. Millions of cells of different size, shape, color, and density, go to make up the heart. Again different ones for the lungs, liver, kidneys, stomach, legs, arms and etc. These organs and structures are also placed in a common position, alike, in all babies. Here is that SOMETHING, which places

bones, muscles, ligaments, cartilages, nerves, and all other structures, and is doing all simultaneously, not even forgetting or mixing them. Not only placing them, but regulating the size, the position, the place. This is all arranged and completed in the course of 280 days. Can you imagine you or I even attempting educationally such a job? We could not, with all the education in existence, commence to build or fashion even one tissue cell, and it is wise that we cannot. Intelligence has her plans which are sane. Innate and Innate alone is the only one that can build a child.

The child is then expelled into the outer world and continues to grow, expand, and develop. After birth it is given food, then later it selects its own food or nourishment. Speaking of food, we educationally can select our foods. We put it in our mouth, where it is masticated, then we swallow that food. Did you ever stop to think that here at this point is where we educationally lose all control of it. Yet that food is chewed, certain elements or juices are brought in contact with it, not educationally but Innately, to bring about certain actions, and a breaking down process. Certain elements are then taken out at a particular place and then passes on a little further. More juices of an entirely different nature are again brought forth, and again certain elements are absorbed into the system for nourishment for certain cells. That process continues for hours, changing and re-changing until the nourishment required is taken into the system, and distributed wherever needed and for whatever purpose, both for immediate and future needs, and also to close or distant parts. And then the waste material which cannot be utilized for bodily development is eliminated. What a wonderful laboratory we have within ourselves and yet we educationally could not even begin to attempt to set up a laboratory that would duplicate even a small portion of that great work being carried on within our bodies, twenty-four hours of the day, day after day, year after year, until Innate finds the house, or concrete portion, no more a fit place in which to reside. In other words the house is worn out. This marvelous and stupendous job being carried on within the body is the work of a power, Innate Intelligence.

Let us, for a few moments, take another view of that SOMETHING, Innate Intelligence, from another angle. We have all seen, at one time or another, some person with a broken bone. It is a commonly known fact, that immediately after the break, each end of the broken bone commences to develop and throw out new bone cells, and in the course of only a few weeks that bone has thoroughly and strongly united, and is again ready for use. Did we educationally, or any other person educationally, do that wonderful master-piece of repairing? Not only does it take place in one bone, but in all bones, in all people. It is the work of that inner power of which we have no control, Innate Intelligence.

You may cut your finger, cut your flesh anywhere on the body, and immediately, Innate produces a serum, of a watery-like nature, which commences to repair and to fill in the cut or wound. This is just another one of the numerous evidences of the proof of Innate Intelligence within the human being. I could also go into at great length and prove and show the same evidences of this Intelligence in the lower kingdoms.

In the preceding chapters, I have given proofs of the existence of Universal Intelligence being the guiding power over all the universe. Also there are proofs of the existence of an Innate Intelligence within each and every one of us. In addition, we all know that everything is in motion, in a state of vibration. The principle of vibration embodies the truth that motion is manifest in everything in the universe. Nothing is at rest. Everything moves, vibrates, and circles. All particles of matter are in circular movement, from microscopic in size to suns and planets. The planets revolve around the suns, and many of them turn on their axes. The suns move around greater central points, and these are believed to move around still greater, and so on, ad infinitum. The molecules, of which the particular kinds of matter are composed, are in a state of constant vibration and movement around each other, and against each other. Molecules are composed of atoms, which, likewise, are in a state of constant movement and vibration. Atoms are composed of electrons, which also, are in a state of rapid motion, revolving around each other. So it is with the various forms of energy. Science teaches that light, heat, and electricity, are but forms of vibratory motion. X-rays are a form of vibration.

The bodies of human beings are in motion and move as a unit. Man is a composition of highly organized, highly specialized matter, being run by highly organized, highly specialized mind, or energy. Let us analyze man for a moment. He is composed of a great number of different organs different structures, all of which are in constant motion and vibration. Each organ and each structure is composed of great numbers of different kinds of particles or cells, which are also in constant motion. Science has proven that man is composed of trillions and trillions of cells, all of which are in motion, that is, in the living man. Therefore man is composed, as mentioned before, of concrete matter and an abstract energy, both of which are united as one, in order that there be life. Consequently, it must naturally follow, logically that this energy is generated by Innate Intelligence, somewhere in that body. It is a known fact, that the brain, so to speak is the motor of the body. Remove the brain and death is instantaneous.

The spinal cord and the nervous system is a continuation of the brain. Without nerves we are functionless, we are motionless. It has been proved clinically and also in the laboratory, that there is a direct continuity of fibers from brain

cell to tissue cell. For reference, as to the laboratory findings of a direct continuity of brain cell to tissue cell, I wish you to refer to the book, "Bipolar Theory of Living Processes," by Crile, of Cleveland, Ohio. Man is the multiplication of the simple cycle, which constitutes one brain cell one efferent fiber, one tissue cell, and one afferent fiber. At the time of writing, Crile has also proven that there are at least four hundred trillion cells in the body. I am of the opinion, that the number of cells in the human body, are greatly in excess of that figure and the true count will never be known or discovered by man. Therefore each cell has its direct continuity.

Man is composed of cycles. For instance, we have the blood circulation, which is a cycle, the serous circulation, nervous system, all of which are cycles. The first two named are those carrying concrete matter, but the cycle of the nervous system is the one carrying the abstract, or energy. It is this cycle over which or through which the mental impulse supply is carried from brain cell to the tissue cell and back to the brain cell. If we cut a nerve, we have the absence of sensation or motion. Some people may say, that it must be proven to them in a laboratory before they will believe. If you are one of the doubters, ask yourself, "what is electricity"? Has it been proven in a laboratory what electricity is? And still, electricity has been one of the greatest assets in the world of progress. No one in the world can prove what electricity is, yet we use it, knowing it is a fact, because it has been proven clinically. Can you take any form of energy into a laboratory and prove it? No. There are many things in this world that cannot be proven in a laboratory, but we know they exist as facts, from clinical findings.

Now, the question comes before us; What is disease? What part does Chiropractic play in disease? Dis-ease is an effect, not a cause. There must be a cause in order to have an effect. Dis-ease is a broken continuity from brain cell to tissue cell. If we have 100% energy flowing through 100% matter, we then have health, or no dis-ease. If there is no energy flowing through 100% matter, it is death. If there is only 95% energy flowing through 100% matter, there is some dis-ease, or incoordination, or lack of harmony. If there is only 50% energy flowing through 100% matter, there is a greater percentage of dis-ease, or incoordination. Dis-ease is the same thing in all people. Dis-ease is an effect. The cause of all dis-ease is a pressure on a nerve or nerves, interfering with the transmission of a normal, mental impulse supply from brain to tissue cell. A living person is 100% motion. A diseased person is only partial motion. A dead person is no motion.

Chiropractic is a philosophy, science, and art of things natural, a system of adjusting a segment of the spinal column, by hand only, for the correction of the cause of all disease.

continuity fiber from brain cell to tissue cell, and from tissue cell to brain cell. The spinal cord is a continuation of the brain. The nervous system of the body, is a continuation of the spinal cord. The tissue cell is a continuation of the nervous system. All nerve fibers pass out, or have a connection passing out from the skull through the foramen magnum, and then into the neural canal, formed by the vertebrae. Between each vertebra, fibers lead out from this spinal cord, and go to their respective tissue cells, all over the body. According to the structure of the vertebral column, as recently discovered by our science, it is only possible to have a subluxation at one of two places; namely, at the Atlas or Axis region. This has been proven, clinically and otherwise, to be the weak link in the entire vertebral column, where a subluxation can be created by an invasional force thereby, resulting in pressure on nerve fibers in the spinal cord.

A subluxation is a condition of three co-related vertebrae; more than a misalignment, which have in part lost their normal relationship in juxtaposition, where it does occlude a foramen; does produce pressure upon nerves; does offer interference to transmission; does create resistance to transmission of mental impulse supply between brain and body; and does thereby become the cause of disease in one or multiple places in the body below or above.

The Chiropractor, who is competent, through the use of a neurocalometer, determines when the pressure is present, then from the spinograph, he learns the subluxation of the patient, seeing the abnormal position of the major vertebra. He then delivers an adjustment. An adjustment is an external concussion of forces, scientifically applied, by hand only, which arouses an internal concussion of forces, correcting the subluxation, thereby releasing pressure on nerves restoring the transmission of a normal mental impulse supply from brain cell to tissue cell.

Chiropractic was released to the world in 1895, through the medium of D. D. Palmer. Like all sciences it has evolved, and this process of evolution, which has developed a higher efficiency of the science, was and is being carried on to greater efficiency by our Developer, Leader, and Master, B. J. Palmer. Chiropractic has lived through 39 years of severe criticism, and will continue to live because it has foundation and merit.

It has been my purpose to briefly outline, and endeavor to prove to others, the firm belief which is in my mind, that the science of Chiropractic, is the connecting link between the abstract and the concrete, the immaterial and the material. If my purpose has been accomplished, even, in a small way, I will feel it is a work worth-while.
